			(C) The Golden Dragons continued SRP and RIF operations throughout assigned A/O. Unusually heavy movement was reported by SRPs and platoon sized patrols throughout assigned A/O, however no direct enemy contact was reported. Three rounds of incoming 82mm Mortar fire was received at LZ Bunker Hill, but all rounds landed well outside the perimeter and caused no damage and no casualties.
