10 March 1969 Summary								
(C) The Golden Dragons continued operations within area of operations. A and C Companies continued mission of BDA. D Company continued SRP operations. A Company had a meeting engagement with an estimated enemy company size element. The N A element had apparently entered the Arc Light area sometime after the bombing. A Company suffered several casualties from small arms initially, and later from B-40 rockets and 82MM mortar. Company A was reinforced by C Company which was operating in the same general vicinity and by A Company 1/69 Armor. The 3 elements linked up and consolidated in a defensive position. Incoming mortar fire continued to be received as late as 1709 hours in spite of massive artillery suppressive fires employed. Initial body count would indicate that enemy loses much outweighed our own.								
(C) Plans: Companies A and C will continue BDA operation, supported by elements of the 1/69th Armor. B Company will remain OP/CON to the 1/12 Infantry at LZ Roberts. D Company will continue SRP operations.
