SRP #51 received approx 6 rounds of incoming 82MM mortar fire with negative casualties. SRP #52 also reported enemy movement. Artillery was employed and movement ceased. No further enemy contact was reported during the day.							
(C) Plans: SRP and RIF operations will be continued. A Company will assume the mission of 2nd Brigade rapid reaction force with their 2nd platoon as the reaction platoon.
