2.	0010	0012	(U) Co B to Bn: I have movement on an azimuth of 180 degrees, approximately 25 meters out. One individual sighted. Employing M-79 and frag grenades at the time. Info passed to Bde.		GC
3.	0030	0031-	(C) Te Bn CO Fm Bde. The following areas will be for Snoop AO on 28 March. YA 9073-8760 ZA 0160-0104.		
4.	0335	0337	(U) Bn CO to Bde. At approximately 0245 hours SRP 22 had rounds impact in his vicinity and received frags into his position, slightly scratching one man and wounding another. SRP will be withdrawn. He was apparently wounded by friendly artillery, which was on target approximately 800 meters away. SRPs location had been confirmed by the firing of 81MM illumination and by use of resection. Initial check of artillery firing data shows no error in either computation of data or lay of the gun. The incident will require investigation to determine the facts.
