The MSF detained a woman and child during the day and the woman stated that her husband has been a VC for the past 2 years, they evacuated them to the District Headquarters. Contact was made during the day by the MSF with 2 VC, resulting in negative casualties on both sides.		
			(C) Plans: Company B 1/14 Infantry will conduct a Combat Assault into an area, where an intelligence report stated a highly possible rice/weapons cache might be found. They will be reinforced by the Recon element of the 1/14 Infantry. The Recon element will complete the closing out of LZ Sylvia.
