The Recon element is at LZ Saint George. 4.2 mortars are at LZ LZ Yvonne. The 106RR element is at LZ Saint George. PLANS SUMMARY: A Company will continue to secure LZ Saint George with their 2nd platoon providing security for the CST and the engineers working on highway #14. B Company will move from NL and RIF to vic 821118 and set up bushmasters at night. C&D Companies will remain CP/CON to the 3rd Brigade. The Recon element will provide security for LZ Saint George and prepare for an operation to the west of same.		RM

			(C) The Golden Dragons continued RIF operations within assigned A/O. Early this morning elements of B Company at LZ Yvonne received approx 20 rounds of 82M mortar fire, followed by enemy saper attacks, resulting in 4 enemy KIA and 2 AK-47 CIA with 3 friendly WIA. At approx the same time LZ Saint George spotted enemy sapers on the SW side of the perimeter killing 4 and when their counterparts tried to retrieve their bodies employed small arms and M-79, resulting in a total of 8 Enemy KIA and negative casualties.		
			(U) Plans: The 1/14 Infantry will continue RIF operations.
