A Cobra gunship was shot down by enemy automatic weapons fire from a bunker complex in general vic BR 023224. As result of this action Company D was inserted in that area with the mission of RIF. The Bn S-3 spotted the downed aircraft and directed the ARPs to the area to secure the aircraft. Sporadic enemy contact was made throughout the day, resulting in negative friendly casualties and unknown enemy casualties.
