14	1108	1109	(U) To NCS from B Company. Our 1st platoon, at grid 878204, found one 55 gallon drum, American type, Federal stock no. 365-690-8655-K764 underneath that it had RIOT CONTROL CS-1. This drum had a 3/4 inch piece of det cord protruding from the top of the drum with a detonator on the end of the det cord. The drum was approx 3/4 underground facing the trail. On one side of the trail there was a stick 13 inches in length and 3 inches in width, pointing straight to the drum. Bark was stripped from the stick. Also to the south west approx another camp site where it looks as though they could have observed the insertion of 1st platoon.	Bde	GC
