			Plans Summary: A Company continues to defend Weigt Davis with 5 two day SRPs to the north, northeast, east, southwest, and south; provide security for mine sweep of Weigt Davis road to junction of Hwy 14; conduct sweep with squad size element along blue line to the east of Weigt Davis in search of MIA; remainder of element conducts care and cleaning of weapons and equipment; 1st platoon continues to secure 4.2 mortars and artillery platoon at LZ Melody; if 4.2 and artillery are airlifted out, 1st platoon will remain in area as stay behind element and be taken out later. B Company continues to conduct search and clear operations in the draws and low lands vic 9115 with Recon platoon attached; during the hours of darkness area bushmasters will be conducted; one squad at Weigt Davis in conjunction with search for MIA lost in blue line. C Company conducts a standdown at St. George with care and cleaning of weapons and equipment; puts out 5 two day SRPs to the north, northwest, west, and southwest; provide security for mine sweep of Hwy 14 to the north and south of Hwy 14; maintain one platoon on 15 minute standby. D Company moves from NL to the west in AO Frontier IV with CP and two platoons going into LZ at vic ZA052162 to secure 4.2 section and maintain reserve for one platoon inserted to the west of the box vic 087187 and one platoon inserted at 020158; platoons will be conducting RIF along draws, ravines, and known infiltration routes. Recon continues to conduct search and clear operations in mouth of valley vic 9115 as B Company continues to block; after area is swept, Recon moves to the south on intelligence mission. 4.2 Mortars one section will be airlifted from Weigt Davis into hipshoot vic ZA 052162 in support of D Company operation. Air request: one LOH first flyable all day for CA, one slick first (cont'd)
