B Company will continue to conduct platoon size RIF to the south from NL and cordon and search of villages along Ia Ayun river and conduct area bushmaster during the hours of darkness. C Company will continue defense of St. George with 5 two day SRPs to the north, northwest, west, and southwest; provide security for minesweep of Hwy 14; 2nd platoon conducts sweep to road from platoon AO 7715, 7712, 8015, 8012 to conduct daylight RIF and one stationary bushmaster and one area type bushmaster during the hours of darkness. D Company continues work in Ivy I with the 1st platoon sweeping to the south along the blue line checking for caches and likely hiding places moving towards the company hip sheet for extraction on 25 Sept; 2nd platoon sweeps north, northwest crosses blue line checking the river toward hip sheet site for extraction. Recon will continue to help defend St. George in conjunction with standdown also receive class on anti intrusion device. Air request: One LOH first flyable for 4 hours for VR and CC, one slick first flyable for backhaul for 2 hours, one slick 1500 hours for resupply.
