B Company moves into Frontier 96 moving from NL toward sugarloaf area to conduct platoon size sweeps and saturation ambushes at night and saturation patrolling during the day. C Company continues defense of St. George with 4 one day SRPs to the north, northeast, southeast, and south; provide security for mine sweep to the north and south of St. George; one platoon on 15 minute standby. D Company 2nd platoon moves from NL to the west on RIF; CP and 4th platoon remain at hipshoot site for security and conduct local patrols in general vicinity; 1st platoon moves from NL to the northeast conducting RIF; 3rd platoon secure hipshoot site of 4.2 section and have local patrols in vic. Recon moves from NL with RF platoon and moves to the west to conduct sweep along blue line to the south gen vic 8002 grid with RF platoon working blue line to the south 8301. C Company 2nd platoon 2/8 repair two tracks that broke down on terrain.
