Closing locations for elements of the 1/14th Infantry, A Company NL is at 796074, 2nd platoon NL is at 845147 and 836164, SRPs at 794085, 806087, 789062, 803058, 838143, 831164, CSF at 764092. B Company NL is at 242075 with SRPs at 231079, 761073, 246063. C Company NL is at 892888, 4th platoon at 856895, SRPs 890894, 890880, 896887, 887887. D Company is at St. George with SRPs at 876155, 891115, 832117, 818152. Recon is at St. George. 4.2 mortars are at Weigt Davis. Flame Platoon 2/8 at St. George. Plans Summary: A Company moves from NL and bushmaster sites to the east gen grid 8408, then move north with the CP and 1st platoon to vic 8309; 3rd platoon moving to vic 8209, bushmaster at night; 2nd platoon continues PF training, attendance 32, class for 8 Oct employment of claymores and pyrotechnics and in the afternoon first aid and medevac procedures, conduct combined bushmasters at night. B Company moves from NL and bushmasters to the north keeping within St. George artillery fan with one platoon moving to the east vic 7807 and then north to vic 7808 or 7809; one platoon and CP will move to the northeast vic 7708 then north 7709 or 7710; the remaining platoon moves from NL north to vic 2409 or 2410. C Company continues operations to the south of Phu Nhon conducting platoon size RIF to the north, west, and south; the RF Co (-) returns to Phu Nhon, element will conduct bushmasters at night. D Company continues defense of St. George with 4 SRPs to the north, east, west, and south; provides security for mine sweep of Hwy 14 to north and south of St. George; conduct day patrols in vic of blue line vic of MIA and to the south vic 8715 to 9011. Recon conducts maintenance standdown at St. George with care and cleaning of weapons and equipment. Mech platoon conduct area recon of Weigt Davis for familiarization of area. CSF move to the east of NL to vic 8108 then north to vic 8110. Rat Patrol will provide security for 815th Eng survey team. Air request: one LOH for 4 hours for VR and CC first flyable, one slick first flyable for resupply for 1 1/2 hours, one slick at 1500 hours for resupply for 1 1/2 hours.
