Recon is at St. George. 4.2 mortars are at Weigt Davis. Flame plt 2/8 are at St. George. Plans Summary: A Company remains at St. George with 5 SRPs to the north, east, west, south, and southeast; provide security for minesweep of Hwy 14 north and south; remainder of element conducts zeroing and squad musketry. B Company moves from NL and bushmaster sites to the east grid 8015 to conduct platoon size sweeps to the north and south; one platoon size stay behind will be left in area of NL; area bushmasters will be conducted during the hours of darkness; 1st platoon will initiate 1st day of PF training program at 873053 and 870037, subject-squad tactics with practical exercise. C Company continues to conduct combined operations to the south of Phu Non moving from NL and bushmaster sites to the south to gen grid 9074 to conduct platoon size and squad size cloverleafs; one staybehind will be left in vic of NL; RF platoon terminates their portion of operations and returns to home base. D Company continues to conduct platoon size operations to the southwest of St. George with the 2nd platoon moving from bushmaster sites to the west vic 7702; CP and 1st platoon from NL to the northeast vic 8404; 3rd platoon from bushmasters to vic 7700; all elements will have bushmasters at night. Recon conducts standdown at St. George and prepares for an operation to the north of St. George. Mech Platoon conducts day patrol along Hwy 14 from St. George north to vic 8021 conducting RIF of the road to the east. Air request: one LOH first flyable for VR and CC for 4 hours, one slick for backhaul first flyable for 2 hours, one slick at 1430 hours for resupply for 2 hours.	B Company Bde	JRF
