| 13 | 1930 | 1931 | (U) To NCS from A Company. Bushmaster 14 at grid 823977 spotted 4 individuals directly in front at 40 to 75 meters out. Received 3 rounds of automatic fire. Employed small arms and grenades. Employing artillery, first round landed at 1943 hours. EOM at 2008 hours. Sweep in the morning. | Bde | JRF | | |
| 14 | 2040 | 2041 | (U) To NCS from D Company. D (-) at grid 822062 spotted 2 lights and employed starlight scope and spotted 3 individuals, one with headgear moving to north-northwest. Individuals were due south 250 meters out. TOT at 2057 hours. Employing M79 at 2110 hours. At 2115 requested dustoff for 5 individuals (urgent), 1 US KIA by friendly artillery fire. Initial report 10 injured, 5 seriously. Now 2 dead. Grid fired is 82390580. Dustoff on station at 2152 hours and complete at 2213 hours. 7 WIA and 2 KIA. CO received light injuries, no dustoff required. WIA are 2Lt Valdis Lumans (666), Thomas Golden (745), Charles Atkins (640), Robert Dobbs (660), Raymond Edwards (664), Michael Mahoney (705), Manuel Sandoval (775). KIA are Jimmie Brown (645), FO SGT Sawyer. Dustoff requested again at 2340 hours. Dustoff 69 enroute on station at 2355 hours and off station at 0011 hours. Two more WIA are Juan Olan-Mercado (811) and SGT Harvey Adams. Total— WIA is 10, KIA is 2. | Bde | JRF | | |
