Ranger 26 and 25 (LRP) at 913201; Ranger 30 and 1 at 922159. Plans Summary: A Company 1st platoon moves from NL and bushmaster sites to the northeast gen grid 8302; 2nd platoon moves from NL and bushmasters to the north 8104; company moves to the north 8202; bushmasters at night. B Company remains at St. George with 4 SRPs to the north, northeast, south, and northwest; provide security for mine sweep of Hwy 14, conduct sweep of vic of perimeter; 1st platoon improves NL no classes on 19 Oct, attendance 18 Oct was 38. C Company 3rd platoon moves on a western axis to the north to vic 8212; 2nd platoon moves on an eastern axis to the same grid with C (-) directly north and conduct bushmasters at night. D Company begins to destroy bunker complex after ambushing the area, moves to the north to 7809 grid checking the low grounds and blue lines. Recon conducts 24 hour standdown in preparation for operations to the northwest of St. George. Mech Platoon provides security for survey team working on Hwy 14 with remaining APC at St. George.
