B Company remains at LZ Lois; provides 5 SRPs to the north, northwest, east, southeast, and south; conduct sweep around LZ at first light and again just before dusk; provide security for mine sweep of road to and from LZ Lois to Hwy 14; remainder of element continues to clear fields of fire and construct fighting positions. C Company is OPCON to 1st Bde at Ban Me Thout South. D Company moves to the south to vic 8110 conducting cloverleafs to the east and west in route; conduct ambushes along likely sites during hours of darkness; 2nd and weapons platoons remains at NL for security and continues in constructing fighting positions and clearing fields of fire. Recon remains at LZ Lois clearing fields of fire and constructing fighting positions; platoon on 15 minute standby for reaction to 1/14 elements in AO. S-5 Team will continue to conduct medcap operations in Buon to the north of LZ Lois as was conducted on the 15th; 1/14th will continue to assist District in the displacement of Buon location in the 9018 grid to an area located in the 9114 grid.
