B Company continues night operations with ambushes around the west of Mewal plantation; company(-) moves to ambush sites vic 8322 to ambush suspected enemy routes of travel from southwest; 1st platoon operates in the northern AO conducting night operations vic 8424; 3rd platoon continues search for and employment of suitable ambush locations in the southern platoon AO vic 8521. C Company continues the Mewal plantation operation conducting night operations along the east perimeter interdicting enemy routes of travel into the plantation from northeast and east; 1st platoon moves from ambush sites to ambushes vic 8724; company(-) continues to employ ambushes around the perimeter of the Mewal vic 8723; 3rd platoon operates in the southern platoon AO to conduct night operations vic 8721. D Company(-) remains at FB Lois for security and construction of positions and clearing fields of fire; a SRP screen will be maintained during hours of darkness; squad sweeps will be conducted once during the morning and once prior to darkness; a mine sweep of the utility road to Hwy 14 will be conducted during the morning; 2nd platoon remains in target area C vic 790120 to provide security for S-5 team, they will conduct night operations in vic with ambushes along trails and stream junctions. Recon assists in security of FB Lois and continues to improve fighting positions and clearing fields of fire; element remains on 15 minute RRF. 4.2 mortars continues clearing LZ Purtle, 4.2 element on FB Lois and will provide fire support with 2 tubes while constructing positions for remainder of tubes. B Company(-) 2/35 CA approx 0800 hours from NL vic 8716 to proposed fire support base to be constructed in 8724; element will clear area and prepare to receive A 2/9 (-) approx 1030 hours.
