Plans Summary: A Company will move from ambush sites to clear Hwy 430, starting vic 872242 to 855215 insuring that both sides of road have been cleared and free of possible ambushes; element will use a mine detector to clear road from Marie to vic 838198 where it will join mine sweep from Lois; 1st and 4th platoons will continue to provide security for LZ Marie; after mine sweep A Company will convoy to BMT east. B Company at BMT east will prepare air head for battalion occupation on 29 Dec; 3rd platoon attached to C Company for security of B 7/17 Cav ASP. C Company will remain CHOP 1st Bde for security of B 7/17 Cav and ASP. D Company will continue security of FB Lois with SRP screen and perimeter sweeps; security will be provided for mine sweep of Hwy 430 to vic 838198; remainder of personnel will prepare for loading and moving of FB Lois. Recon will move from ambush sites to clear area along Hwy 430 from 855215 southwest to 833190; after mine sweep recon will convoy to BMT east. 4.2 will remain at FB Lois to provide heavy organic fire support.
