The final list of captured gear for the 2nd Co. was 3 AK-47, 1 AK-50, 1 B-40 launch, 10 kilos of rice. C^o at 640303 found numerous bundles and personal gear also an RPG round and a tilt rod mine 300 meters south there were 3 US. entrenching tools, 2 M-16 empty magazines and 3 NVA uniforms.

At 2045 hrs an ARVN AP engaged unknown sized enemy force at 588211. They received ^{AK} return fire. The area was swept with negative findings. CRIP spotted 9 individuals at 591210 but could not engage because of friendly fire in the area.
